



Carbon Capture

Southwold Press has signed up with their paper supplier, Premier Paper Group, for Carbon Capture. This means we capture the CO₂ emissions from all of our paper purchases by planting native woodland, right here in the UK, through the Woodland Trust and the Woodland Carbon scheme.

Southwold Press was Premier Paper's 6th Woodland Trust customer, and we are only one of 12 printers to be doing this in the UK.

When we place our paper order with Premier Paper Group we elect to capture the carbon from the manufacture and distribution of the paper. The amount of CO₂ generated in the production and delivery of our paper is calculated at £8.50 per tonne and recorded on our invoice as a cost to Southwold Press, (75% of the cost goes to the purchasing of the trees and 25% goes to the planting and management of the woodland area). One tonne of paper purchased equates to 14m² of woodland and captures 1/2 tonne of CO₂.

The tree planting programme happens in the spring and autumn season. For small quantities

of trees purchased through the Woodland Carbon scheme, these will be planted in a wood designated by the Woodland Trust.

Woodland Carbon is an accredited, award-winning carbon removal scheme that is operated under the Government's 2011 Woodland Carbon Code. Organisations looking to reduce their environmental impact and mitigate their carbon emissions can fund tree planting with the Woodland Trust, which is what Southwold Press have elected to do.

So get on board with your local printer, and help us plant more trees and reduce carbon emissions.
